

TLILIC0004 Licence to Operate an Order Picking Forklift Truck (2-Day Course)

This two-day course introduces student to the theoretical and practical elements of safely operating an order picking forklift truck: The course covers subjects such as:

- Risk and risk controls/hierarchy of control
- Selecting the right machine for the task
- Conduct routine checks
- Load movements

- Weight assessment
- Safety and stability
- Shut down and secure machine
- Report defects and damages
- Housekeeping

Upon successful completion of this course, student will be awarded a Statement of Attainment and the High Risk Work License* to Operate an Order Picking Forklift Truck by WorkSafe WA.
