

TLILIC0005 Licence to Operate a Boom-type Elevating Work Platform (Boom length 11m or more)

(2-Day Course)

This two-day course introduces student to the theoretical and practical elements of safely operating motorised elevated work platforms (EWP). The course covers subjects such as:

LEARNING OUTCOME:

- EWP safety awareness
- Harnesses and other personal protective equipment
- Hazard identification and risk controls
- Pre and post operational checks
- EWP orientation

- Australian standards
- EWP orientation (ground controls)
- EWP orientation platform controls
- EWP operation (emergency controls from the ground)
- Emergency controls from the platform

Upon successful completion of this course, student will be awarded a Statement of Attainment and the High Risk Work License* to Operate a Boom-type Elevating Work Platform (Boom length 11m or more) by WorkSafe WA.

(* STES will submit student's WorkSafe application and issue the SOA after full payment is received)
