

## Licence to Operate a Slewing Mobile Crane (TLILIC0010, TLILIC0013, TLILIC0014, TLILIC0015)

### (5-Day Course)

These courses are designed for students to gain the necessary skills to safely operate a mobile slewing crane. Slewing Crane all classes include **C2 (<=20T)**, **C6 (<=60T)**, **C1 (<=100T)** and **CO (Over 100T)** as described in the **National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work**. On completion of the course, student will be able to perform pre-operational checks; set-up and operate the crane competently; shut down and dismantle and perform various operations competently.

#### **PRE-REQUISITE:**

**TLILIC0010 (C2) & TLILIC0013 (C6) – Current DG HRWL**

**TLILIC0014 (C1) & TLILIC0015 (CO) – Current DG HRWL, current C6 HRWL and at least 2 years of current industry experience operating a slewing crane between 20T and 60T**

Upon successful completion of this course, student will be awarded a Statement of Attainment and the High Risk Work License\* by WorkSafe WA.

(\* STES will submit student's WorkSafe application and issue the SOA after full payment is received)

<b>Parking:</b>	Limited free parking on site

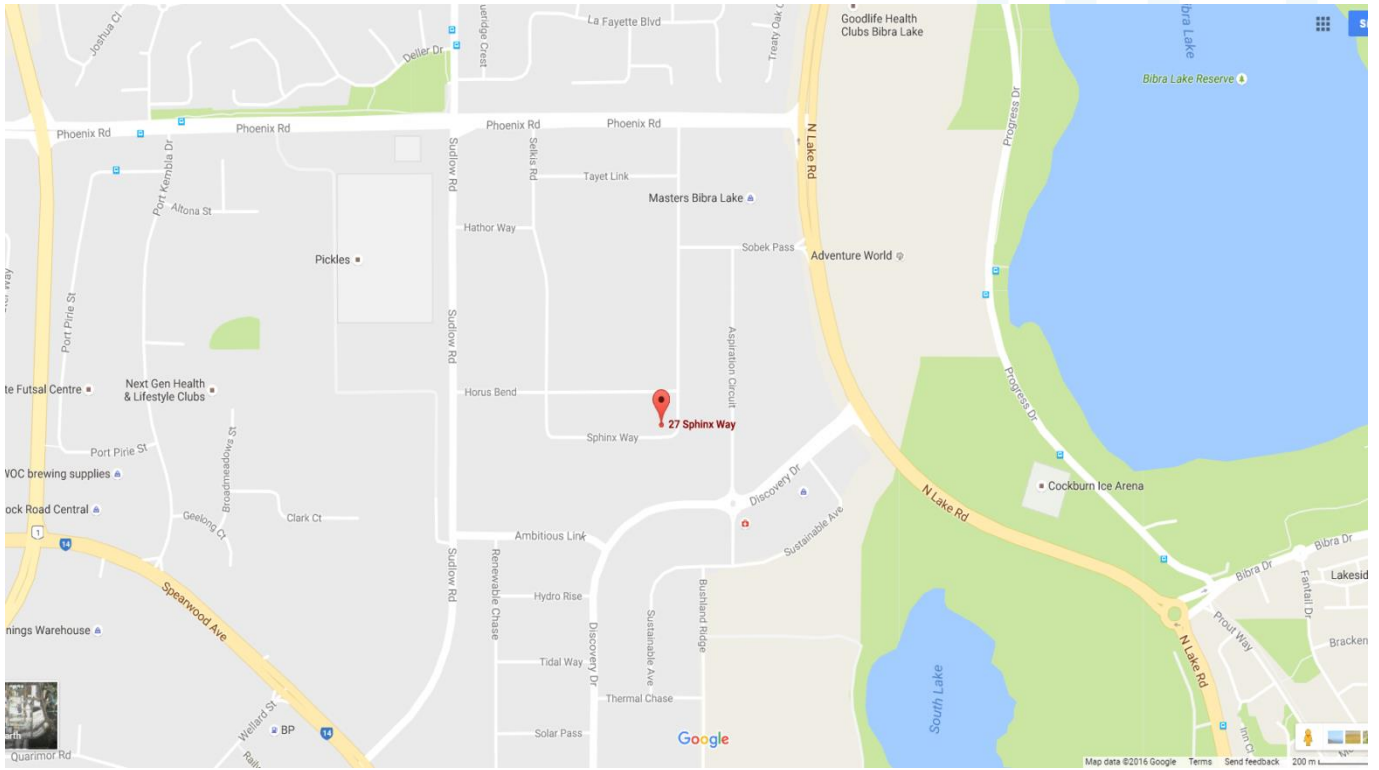
